- a. Liaison (Marwa) - SSPC 62.1

Marwa reports out. Research & Development subcommittee voted to send addendum aa for a full 62.1 committee vote to approve. Guideline 42P will be going out for public review soon.

Question: Can a working addendum in 62.1 be shared and distributed to members in TRG4?

Action Item: Marwa will seek approval/permission to make addendum aa, ab, and ax available to TRG4. Once approved the three addenda will be distributed to the TRG4.

- b. Liaison (Nick) - SSPC 62.2

SSPC 62.2 is making traction on IAQP and TRG4 should have more than one person to be attending. Tori and Dean will be attending with Nick.

A majority of the committee is interested in adopting the IAQ Procedure as a higher performing Standard for ventilation as compared to the Ventilation Rate Procedure (VRP).

- c. Liaison (Tony) - SSPC 145.2

Tony reports out. Small working group was formed to review, comment, and make suggestions about RP1838. Tomorrow during the Zoom meeting this work will be reviewed and next steps will be discussed.

- d. Newly forming MTG with a label – “Reactive Air Cleaners” (Kathleen Owen)

Kathleen reports, it is still in the early phases but was approved by TAC and currently titled “Reactive Air Cleaning and Surface Treatments”

Discussion was about how this new MTG will interact, be involved with, or be different from other TGs TCs and SSPCs in ASHRAE such as 145, 185.3 and others such as AHAM.

- e. *Add Liaison for AHAM AC5 (Chamber Test) – Tony Abate*

Discussion was about draw-down test versus a continuous challenge-gas concentration test in chamber testing.

- f. *Section Head – Jamie Bennet*

Jamie reports out. Overall area D in the activity reports, Objectives, was weak. Work towards aligning TRG4 with ASHRAE’s strategic plan. Reexamine TRG scope and discuss the future vision.

- a. 1869-WS (Work Statement)
 - Evaluation of VOCs with Respect to Development of Revised Standard 62.1 Indoor Air Quality Procedure (IAQP) Design Compounds and Design Limits

- b. RP-1838 (Research Project)
 - Emerging gas-phase electronic filtration technologies and ASHRAE 145.2 test standard

Dean reports. Status update presentation was delivered to the PMS on June 7th. The final report will be on July 26th.

- b. The IAQP presently does not address airborne pathogens (e.g., SARS-CoV-2 virus).
 - a. If so, how should the IAQP address pathogens?

Discussion and decision to keep as a new business item to discuss in the future as new developments become available. At this time IAQP will not address.

- c. Leadership of the TRG4 supports the Motion, Discussion, and Voting on the interest of becoming a TC.

ACTION ITEM: Provide TRG4 with information on the differences between TGs, TCs, MTGs, TRGs, etc. to help membership to better understand the best direction for the TRG4.

ACTION ITEM: Organize an interim meeting with members interested to further discuss. Members interested include Kathleen, Gemma, Charlie, with other interested members from the TRG4 to be contacted for participation.

- d. *Jim Dennison seeks support for the development of an RTAR to fill in the information gaps for things not included in WS 1869 such as bioaerosols, ozone, PM, inorganics, CO2, and SVOCs in buildings. Chang-Seo volunteers to help.*
