Section Head Report (TAC)

Jim Tauby: Next meeting in Kansas City, KS – No refrigeration track for summer – Submit refrigeration proposals by February 8th (Friday) to be dropped into another track. ASHRAE has 118 tech committees, by Orlando (within 1 year) that will be reduced to 34 TCs, by mergers. TCs will become “Technical Working Groups” (TWGs).

Group discussion expressed dismay for a vast reduction that would likely become counterproductive for members that better express themselves in person, versus web meetings. Group also expressed interest in not reducing TCs down to 34, but to instead include Saturday as time for TCs since many members travel to ASHRAE on Friday anyway.
