3. Chapter 47, due into ASHRAE by July 2022. TC needs to vote on chapter in June.

1. Chapter 47 is now on “Revision G”. Anyone who has not received the most recent revision of the chapter contact Brian.
2. Comments from those who reviewed Revision G prior to meeting...
 - o Terminology:
 - Strike out “In particular” from start of paragraph (Gemma)
 - Challenge compound should be added in as a definition (Gemma)
 - Recommendation to make definitions of “Removal Efficiency & Removal Capacity” broader to potentially be accepted as an addition onto ASHRAE’s website terminology page (Gemma)
 - “GAC” is an acronym and should be moved out of the definitions section into the acronyms section (Gemma)
 - “Mass Transfer Zone” definition needs to be updated because as it is currently written does not agree with what is stated in the body of the chapter. (Gemma)
 - Gemma will provide Brian with a reworking of the definition of “Penetration” as well as any other comments on “Revision G” to be included into “Revision H”
3. Discussion about Figure 6 and the use of “airborne molecular contamination”
 - o Shift towards moving away from molecular filtration → gaseous contamination
 - o Would be difficult change to make at this time due to needing consistency across not only in TC 2.3 Chapters but other standards and chapters as well, one or the other needs to be used
 - o Due to the chapter deadline, Chris Muller agreed to find a spot within the chapter to introduce the language and therefore it can also be added into the terminology section under the definition of “Gas Phase” potentially as “also known as”

4. Chapter 47 – Update on actions from last meeting:

1. Brian Krafthefer agreed to check equations (5) and (7) against their counterparts in Standard 62.1 before June meeting. Chang Seo Lee said that Std. 62.1 does not break it down into the number of sources that we do in our Handbook Chapter.
