a) ASHRAE Data Dictionary Task force – volunteer to join the ad-hoc committee

-Bruce Billedeaux - He said Mark Palmer is asking for a data dictionary. Staff would like to make it electronic. SPC166 (HVAC &R Terminology) will be all XML. Gordon Holness is pushing this. Job is to use ASHRAE Data Dictionary Task force as part of solution. Need volunteer from 1.5 that can understand the system. Need to understand 1) process in general in an automated environment 2) understand restrictions and possibilities. Commitment is to be less than 1 year. Roth volunteered.

2) Update from Cliff Holle about Mapping Survey. Scanned a .5 million square ft. GSA building for HVAC features with a scanner that is mounted above tile line of 1905 courthouse for renovation. Goal is to move to BIM ; Technology is a Geographic Information Systems (GIS) combination with mechanical features – this technology is heading for HVAC industry. See BIM focused on tool for new construction but what about all these existing facilities? Image a 3 dimensional database of all the building structure; convert vast amounts of data and convert to an “as-built” BIM.

3)Proposal by Glaser from GARD Analytics, the contractor for RP-1354 - Simulation Aided Design for High Performance Buildings - Questions were brought up concerning effectiveness and further clarification from Jason is needed for voting on this proposal.
