a. **Working file and ASHRAE Terms Online Update – Art**

- i. Update Status, New Glossaries added to working file – from the previous meeting:
 - 1 Ready to do another cycle with another roughly 400 terms and removing duplicate terms.
 - a 26000 terms in working file now. Updated with new decarb terms. New definition for Built Environment. Been Published to all with 128 terms that we want to move over to online version. If approved, it goes to editor and finalized. Updated the working file of online terms. Added some ICC terms from the ICC Standard. Added air

- Subgroups of the working file are now working on terminology of their interest. Decarb is the biggest example.
- Newest subgroup is air cleaning glossary. Working on harmonizing the terms.
- Acoustical terms from TC2.6 is interested in harmonizing their glossary as well.
- Should we publish who the subject matter experts are? Overall thoughts of group is yes. Place it in basecamp to where it is available to the committee.
- External organization coordination
- Not currently tracking addendums. Would help to do this.

c. **ASHRAE IP/SI Policy**

- i. SI vs IP – Rational Conversion Review – Walter

Art said no policy exists for the soft conversion “rounding” protocol. Bruce asked if TC1.6 can get involved in the Fundamentals handbook section on Conversions to expand on the guidance for IP/SI conversions. Bruce, Walter, and Stephanie will lead this effort.

d. RP-1801 Journal Newsletter

- i. Past item: Phil Naughton - Perhaps a journal article on the role terminology places in many other ASHRAE publications. I am part of MTG ACR (Air Change Rate), and we just concluded a research project RP-1833, Literature Review for Evidence of the Basis for Specified Air Change Rates (ACR) for Cleanrooms, Laboratories, laboratory animal facilities, and health care facilities with medium to high ACR. There was a significant amount of work in the RP on terminology and the etymology of many of the ventilation terms. Our MTG and its TC subgroups (i.e., Labs, Hospital, Cleanrooms, etc.) continually discuss the meaning of many ventilation terms. Having precise and consensus definitions of terms is critical to many research projects. Perhaps an article discussing this. I might be open to authoring this article or co-authoring it with some others. – Group discussed that TC1.6 supports Phil leading this effort.
